Back-casting and updating of risk model spreadsheets were completed for participating states. A senstivity analysis and examples were developed to illustrate how the models work and be implimented. Weighting of attribute using a multi-objective analysis process was completed. A method to calculate the consequence of a bridge with a numeric scale instead was developed and tested against NBI data. Statistical analysis was performed to analyze potential relationships between condition ratings and condition states based on data from eight states using element level data. Risk models for each state are being summerized and expected to be distributed in the early part of this quarter. See additional notes.

The primary focus for the coming quarter is to finalize draft risk models to share with participating states for review and comment. One objective for the quarter is to circulate the draft risk models for comment on the data sources for the revised models. Work on the final report and the handbook for RBI implementation will continue in the coming quarter for submission in draft final report form later in the quarter. Data from the research will be collated for inclusion in the draft final report.

The project was delayed by the pandemic. The research team has been working toward completing work in as timely a manner as possible. There have been staffing issues due a student leaving the project due to unavoidable circumstances. Recent changes in FHWA policy and the SNBI required updates to the analysis that have been more time consuming than expected. A RAP meeting needs to be held for one remaining state. The final report has been initiated and data is being collated. Every effort is being made to complete the final report in a timely manner.

An analysis of new FHWA guidance policy to summerize the policy has been developed. The risk models for each state are being summurized for distribution to states which has taken longer than expected. The summury provides an analysis that compares the risk models to the FHWA guidance and suggests changes that may be necessary to implement the risk models. Sources of data for all attributes are also analyzed in the summary. Correlating the risk models with the SNBI update has been completed. A summary of the overall proces and the methodology developed for ranking consequence factors is also includes in the summary to be distributed. The summaries provides an analysis of how the models fit with the FHWA guidance for each state, with suggestions for additional screening criteria needed to match FHWA is being completed. Additional data that will be needed for states to impliment the model, such as additional inspection data that may need to be documented, are being assessed for each risk model. The PI has held discussion with FHWA regarding implimentation of guidance in an effort to resolve conflicts and identify expectations. These discussion have been beneficial for clarifying expectations and resolving some conflicts, and discusions are ongoing.
