WORK COMPLETED:

TAC Meetings

- Finalized plans and materials for the spring TAC meeting: travel logistics, problem statement coordination, final agenda, Clear Roads budget, copies of meeting materials, etc. Participated in the meeting, which took place March 27-29.
- Coordinated and participated in a meeting between stakeholders from Clear Roads, AASHTO, Aurora and FHWA to encourage the development and support of specifications that will enable "plug & play" technology for winter maintenance equipment.
- Started planning for a face-to-face meeting of the Clear Roads TAC on September 25-27, 2012. Planning included communication with TAC members, meeting logistics and agenda development.

- Coordinated with MnDOT on the evaluation of proposals for Snow Removal at Extreme Temperatures and also supported the subsequent contracting process.
- Continued to coordinate with investigators and the Clear Roads subcommittees on True Costs of Snow and Ice Control and Weather Mapping Severity Zones projects.

- Development of a Training Video for Deicer Testing: Distributed the DVDs as requested by the TAC.
- Plug and Play Initiative: Coordinated with the project subcommittees and other stakeholders.
