The Office of Research, Development, and Technology announced on July 11 a proposal to initiate a Federal Highway Administration-led Pooled Fund Study entitled "Improving the Quality of Pavement Profiler Measurement." Based on the positive responses received from a number of States, we will initiate this study. Please make arrangements to obligate FY 2003 funds at the State's earliest convenience.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your assistance in coordinating this study.
