Project Description:

This project will seek to understand how implements of husbandry impact the nation's bridges. Further, tools for completing bridge rating with these vehicles in mind will be developed. Additionally, a generic posting vehicle will attempt to be developed. This generic posting vehicle will allow rating engineers to post bridges in such a way that the various types of vehicles will be covered.

Progress this Quarter (includes meetings, work plan status, contract status, significant progress, etc.):

A TAC meeting was held on 9/27/2016 to discuss the observations, conclusions, and recommendations made from this research project. The contents and progress of final report was also reported and discussed.

The final report has three volumes. Volume I is focused on Live Load Distribution Factor and Dynamic Load Allowances. Volume II is focused on Rating and Posting Recommendations. Volumes III is the Appendices that document the detailed information of tested bridges, Husbandry Implement Inventory, Bridge Inventory, and survey responses.

Volume I and Volume III are almost done, and we are working on Volume II now.
