NETC 13-1, This project has been completed. Final report, fact sheet, and poster have been uploaded to the NETC website.

NETC 13-3, Phase I of the final report has been completed and has been uploaded to the NETC website.

NETC 13-3 Phase II, The research team developed the questionnaire to be used for interviewing New England state DOT financial offices. Interviews with CT, ME, and VT were completed. NH provided written answers. MA and RI are still in the works. A survey was also developed to collect information pertaining to QA inspection paperwork and upcoming projects.

NETC 14-1, All interviews were completed. The final report, fact sheet, and poster were also completed.

NETC 15-1, The project team finalized the MYSE distribution modeling and submitted a draft of the final report to the TAC for review and comments.

NETC 15-2, The project team held a TAC conference call in October and December. The team has been revising the draft final report to incorporate feedback from the TAC.

NETC 15-3, This project has been completed. Final report, fact sheet, and poster have been uploaded to the NETC website.

NETC 15-4, A draft report was completed this quarter and is in the process of being finalized.

NETC 17-1, This project has been completed. Final report, fact sheet, and poster have been uploaded to the NETC website.

NETC 17-2, A final TAC meeting was held during December to present draft deliverables. The project team has completed a draft final report.

#### **Potential Implementation:**

Five of the 17 research projects listed above are still in the research phase or working towards a final report. Project 14-1 implementation is not planned by the PI. Twelve research projects (NETC 06-4, 07-1, 09-2, 09 -3, 10-3, 13-1, 13-2, 14-1, 14-2, 14-4, 15-3, and 17-1) have completed their final reports and technical transfer items (poster and fact sheet). Project 17-2 is a six-month long project looking at quantification of research benefits focusing on recent NETC projects. The Advisory Committee is hopeful that this project will provide guidance for themselves and researchers on how to think about implementing these research projects in the future.
